I pray that through the publication of these teaching all beings may realize the genuine teacher's wisdom mind and forever be truly compassionate and joyful.

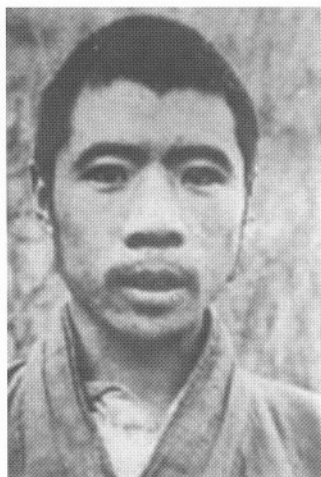
